

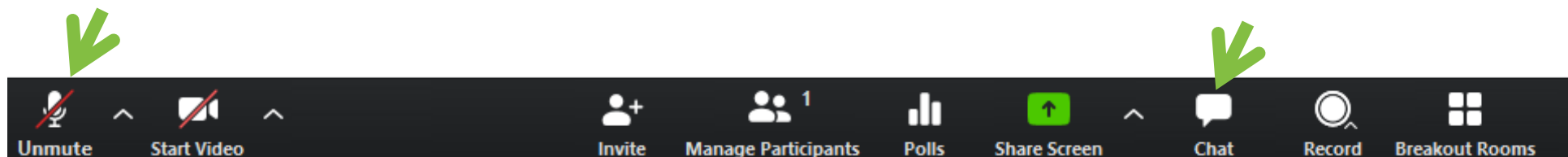

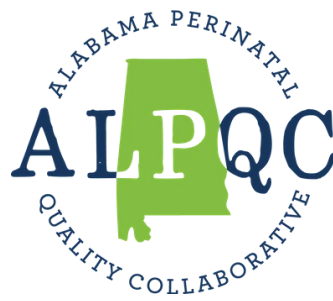
Overall Performance



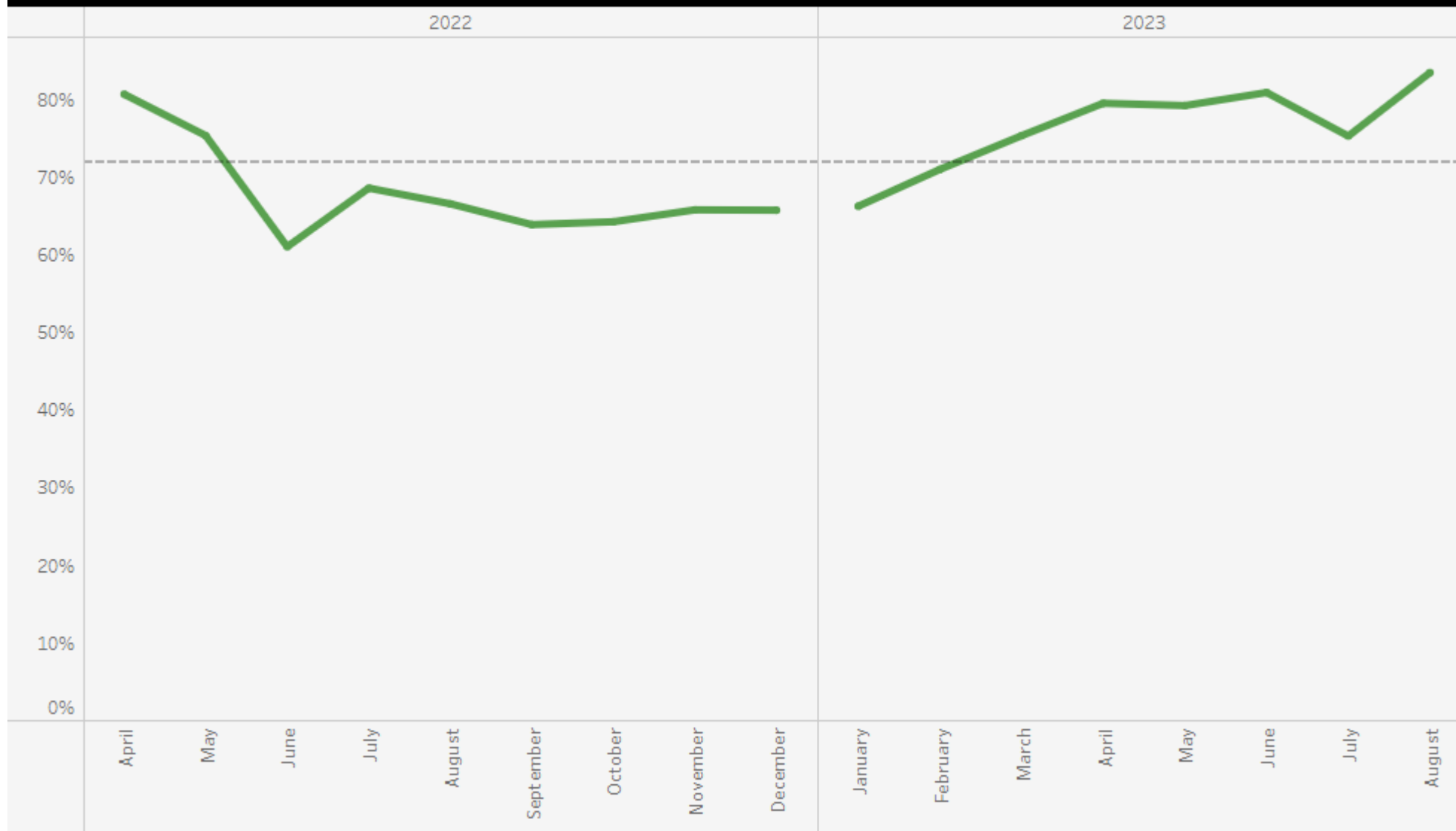
Measures	All Initiative Hospitals (Average)
O1: SMM (Excluding transfusions)	8.84 %
O2: SMM among patients with preeclampsia (Excluding transfusions)	27.55 %
P1: Timely Treatment of Persistent Severe HTN	68.66 %
P2: Follow-up appointment (within 7 days)	53.01 %
P3: Discharge education	79.75 %

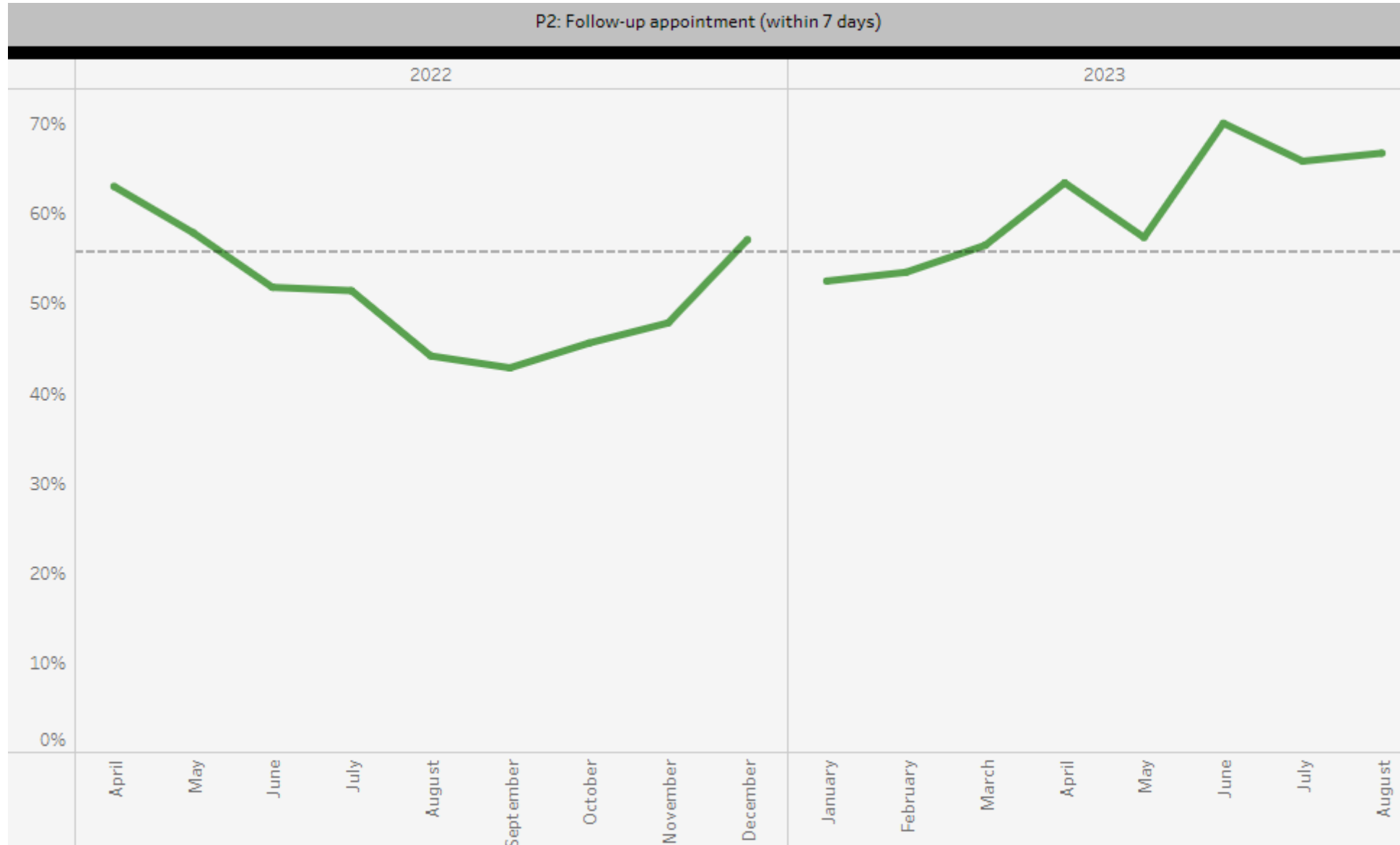


P1: Timely Treatment of Persistent Severe HTN



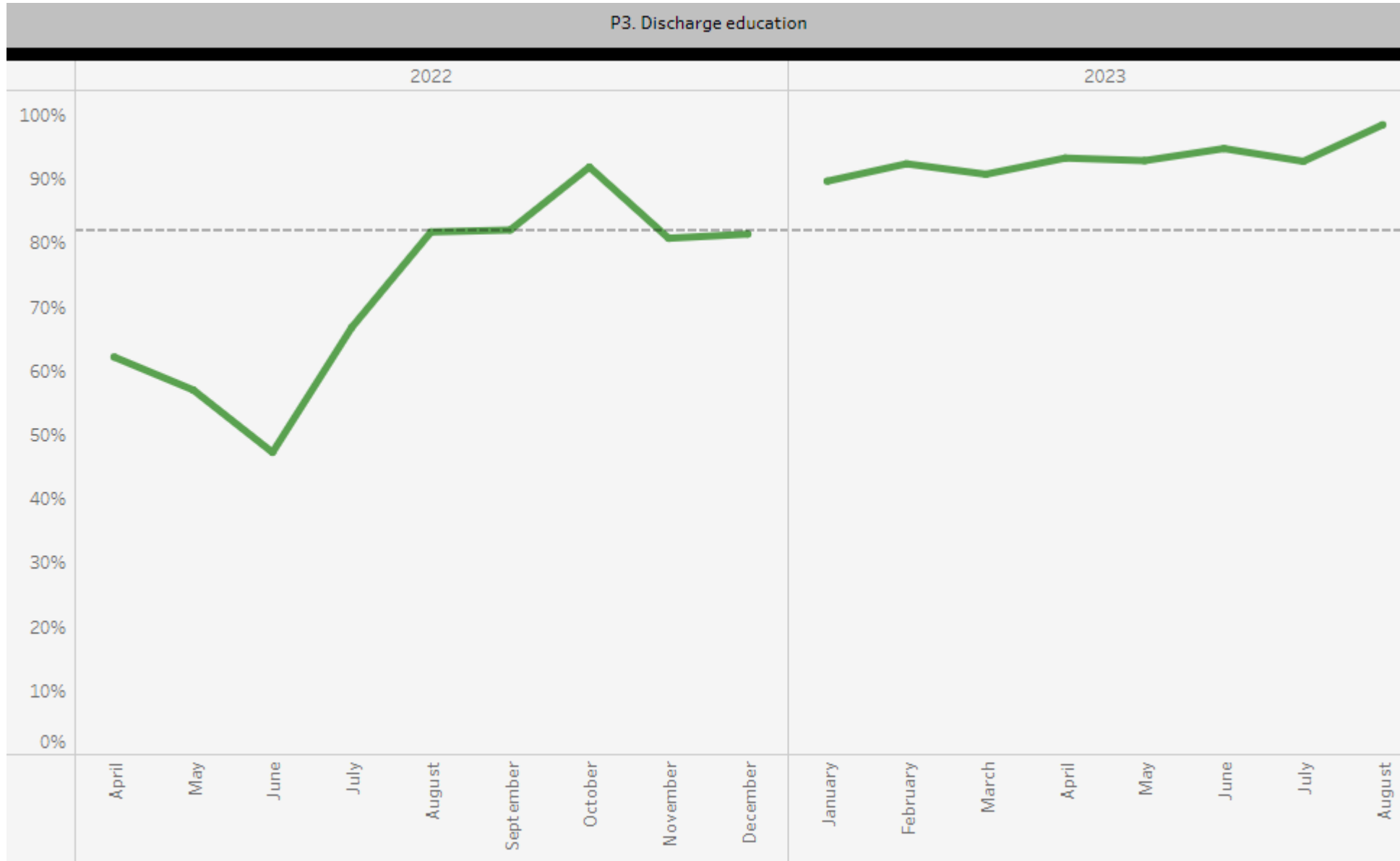
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Follow-Up Appointment within 7 days



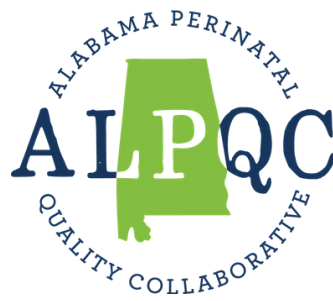

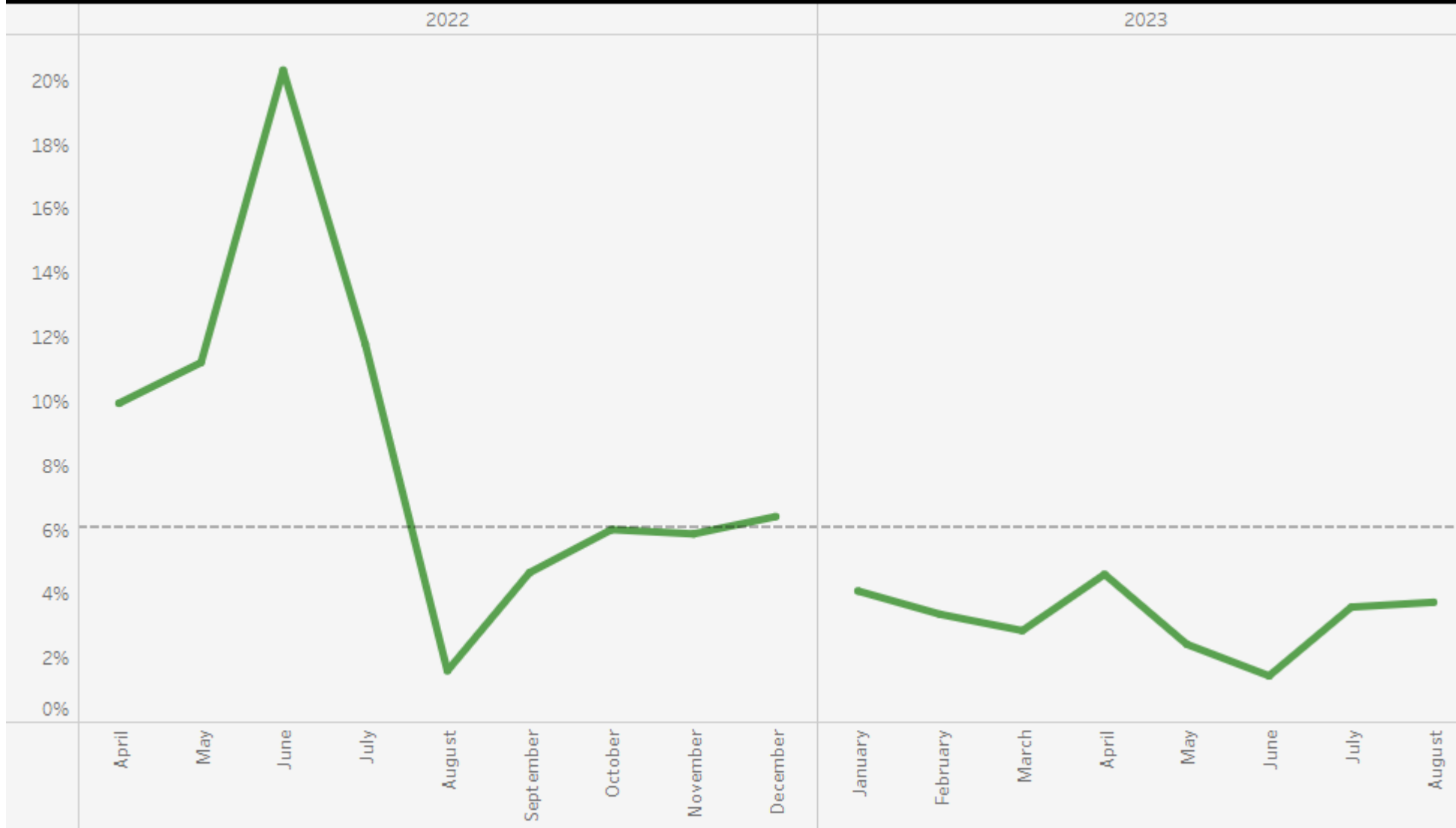

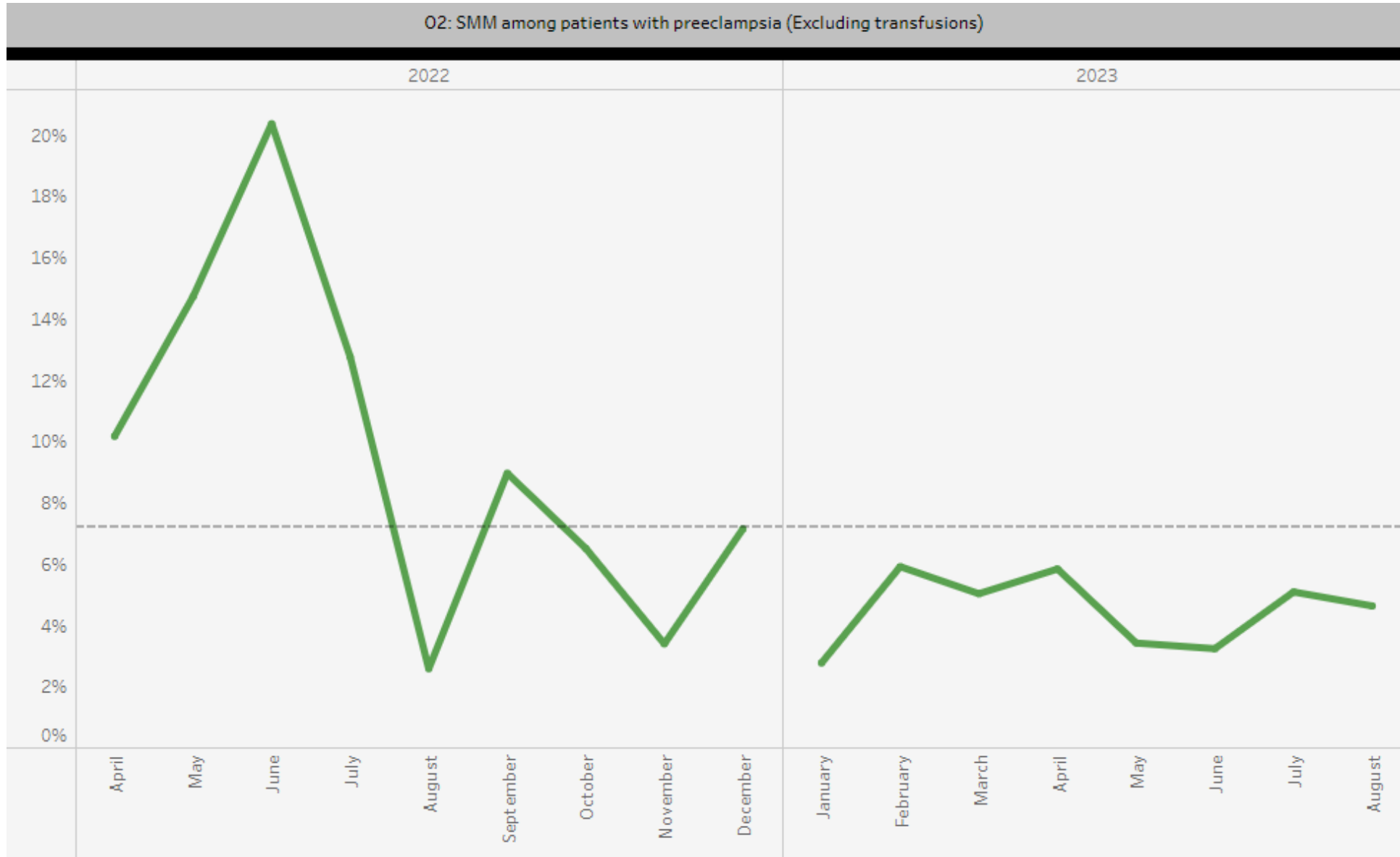
